Focusing on the Balkans, region that is close to my heart, I found a place where I knew that I can learn a lot. My HE was the NGO focused on youth work and cooperating with many international volunteers and partners. I knew that I can take this challenge and learn a lot on the way, as well as the HE had high expectations from a person experienced with work in multicultural environment.
