

REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS

- The copy of your passport (original for inspection) and a copy of your visa.
- A LEGALIZED High School Certificate that entitles you to study for a BA or BSc degree with a sworn Polish translation.
- For MA students also: LEGALIZED BA/BSc Diploma with an official transcript with their sworn Polish translations.
- The original of your health certificate with its Polish translation (for Nursing and Computer Science students).
 - A copy of your insurance policy (both health insurance and accident insurance) valid for the period of your stay in Poland, or your European
- Health Insurance Card, or a declaration by the foreign applicant to join the National Health Fund immediately after the beginning of your studies.
- Parental consent for the candidates under 18 years of age to commence their studies, to sign and submit all documents required in the recruitment process and to meet the financial settlement connected with the initiation of their studies.
- Two 35 x 45mm photos.

In those cases, where the candidate decides to authorize another
person to submit documents and/or represent his/her interests in the recruitment process, they should deliver the relevant authorization document.









VISA PROCESS



When applying for a VISA, you also need to submit your educational certificates for legalization at the embassy.


ARRIVAL AT THE ADMISSION OFFICE

After your arrival in Lublin, you will need to submit the required documents (see page 4 and 5) at the Admission Office – room 02 on the ground floor.





Only after the successful completion of your registration, you will be able to obtain student status.



SWORN TRANSLATION

All educational documents must be translated into the Polish language by a sworn translator.



This task may be performed at the Polish embassy or after your arrival in Lublin (but before registration).
